- ▶ The 1st and only Governor to release the sum of N300million as Initial Capital Grant aside monthly subvention in the over 32 years existence of EKSU.
- ▶ Released N100million for the accreditation of Medical Programme.
- ▶ Ongoing Construction of 2 kilometres road enroute new SUB Building.
- ▶ Ongoing Construction of 2kilometres road from motor park enroute College of Medicine.
- ▶ Medical Library - Completed.
- ▶ New Agricultural Science Faculty Complex - Completed.
- ▶ Anatomy Department Complex - Completed.
- ▶ Physiology Department Complex - Completed.
- ▶ Additional N50 million monthly subvention

- The JKF led administration restored the capital grant which has been suspended by previous administration by releasing a total of One Hundred and Fifty Five Million, Four Hundred and Fifty Five Thousand Naira only (N155,455,000.00) to the college in 2011, 2012 and 2013
- Approval for the implementation of the new salary structure CONTEDESS/CONPCASS in 2011. This had led to the increase in monthly college subvention from Ninety Million Naira Only (N90,000,000.00) to One Hundred and Forty Five Million, Eight Hundred and Sixty Eight Thousand Naira (N145,868,638,00)
- Payment of 21 month arrears of the new salary structure to all deserving members of staff
- Signing of MoU with the University of Manitoba, Canada to run Sub-degree programmes.
- Accreditation of all academic programmes (NCE and B.Ed) by the National Commission for Colleges of Education Abuja. The state government supported the accreditation programmes by releasing the sum of Eighteen Million, Three Hundred and Ninety Three Thousand Naira (N18,393,000.00)
- Establishment of Post Graduate Studies
- Development of the college work force and its staff capacity building has increased with about 50%.
- Commencement of inaugural lectures
- Renovation of old offices and construction of 17 additional buildings
- Construction of new school of vocational and technical education building
- Purchase of 17 vehicles
- The state government donated to the college money for the renovation of the School of Arts and Social Sciences that got burnt in November 2012. New structures are being built, while existing ones have been renovated, eg, the College Guest House

BROADCASTING SERVICES OF EKITI STATE

- The level of professionalism has improved. Promotion exercise was conducted in 2012 for staff.
- The Fayemi Administration through the current DG Alhaji Mojeed Jamiu acquired 4 booster station equipment
- Installation of 2 digital TV studios with state of the art broadcast equipment like HD cameras, MCR equipment for modern recording and play back systems as well as consoles and monitors.
- New digital radio studio acquired to replace the old analogue studio
- Installation of transformer to connect BSES to the power grid
- All the outstanding NBC and BON fees for both the Ekiti FM and EKTU for the past 4 years paid.
- The Broadcasting Services of Ekiti State Law was passed in 2013 which separated the Radio and TV channels under two professional general managers and placed a director general to oversee the operations through the general managers.
- Introduction of welfare packages for staff including the payment of 13th month salary tagged 'Dear Colleague', refurbishment of grounded vehicles to aid the movement of staff
- Purchase of tracking machine for monitoring of big sales adverts to show compliance
- Provision of accommodation for over 30 staff of the programmes and engineering departments
- Procurement of 500kva diesel generator and construction of a fuel dump for dispensing diesel.
- Provision of new set furniture for the *Day-Break-Nigeria* and *Meet-Your-Governor*.
- Procurement of new office furniture for management staff.
- Provision of 4 split air conditioners in the transmitter rooms and TV studio A
- Re-carpeting of the TV/FM studio complex and the introduction of static set in the TV studio
- Procurement of four digital camera with tripod stand, four digital midgets, 6 wired and wireless microphones, four high end computers for editing, control room playout and a digital library
- Newly acquired scrolling machine helps to change the face of EKTU by allowing it to provide real time news all day long including breaking news items
- Construction of work on four booster stations in Efon Alaaye, Aiyedun, Ikere and Otun Ekiti
